

Nurse Volunteers Needed

The ServNY volunteer management system is a web-based registry of health care professionals who are willing to volunteer on behalf of New York State during an emergency. This registry of volunteers may be called upon in response to a natural disaster, widespread disease outbreak, or other public health emergency.

New York State Department of Health developed the ServNY volunteer registry in partnership with county health departments, the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Medical Society of the State of New York, hospital associations, and other medical professional organizations. When registering, volunteers have the option of signing up for ServNY or their local volunteer program.
