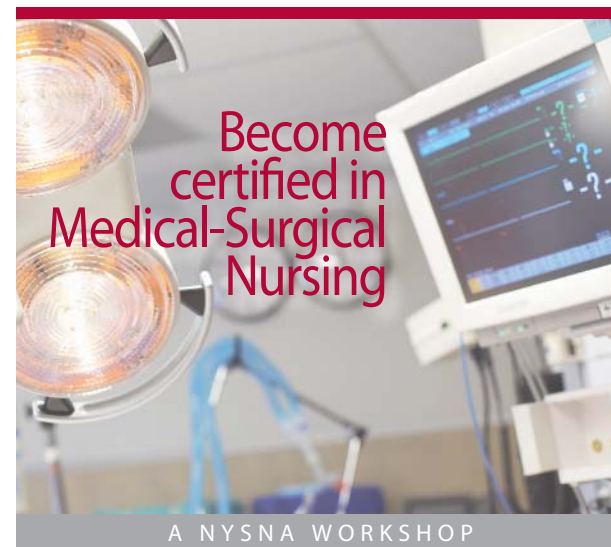

- Relate the pathophysiologic basis of various diseases using the nursing process, including evaluation of effectiveness of nursing care of various medical-surgical patients.
- Review nursing assessment and interventions.
- Outline the legal, ethical and professional responsibilities of the medical-surgical nurse.

Twelve (12.0) contact hours will be awarded for this workshop. In order to receive contact hours, participants are required to attend the entire session and complete an evaluation.
