

Midwife Victory at Bargaining Table

Midwives Now Permanent Part of NYSNA Contract!

Midwives will join the NYSNA Benefits and Pension Funds on 3/1. Progress made on Seniority Accruals during Leave, Posting of Positions, Float Team, and NYSNA Meeting Space

Agreements reached on the following topics:

1. Midwives are now formally incorporated into NYSNA at TBHC- all of our contract's benefits apply to them
2. Seniority will continue to accrue while on a paid leave. Nurses shouldn't lose their seniority if they are on paid time leaves.
3. Nurses will be able to bid on positions within 6 months after hire/transfer if it represents a promotion or shift change opportunity
4. Broad Float Team language enhancing the training and orientation for our Float Team colleagues.
5. Meeting space will be made available for NYSNA LBU Membership meetings.

TBHC and Citywide Pickets a Massive Success!
