NYC Negotiations Update #1

During the last week of October, hundreds of NYSNA nurses turned out at hospital systems where we are negotiating. We were there to support negotiating committees at our first bargaining sessions. On October 23-24, our demands were presented at three of our facilities: NY-Presbyterian Hospital, Mt. Sinai, and Mount Sinai St. Lukes & West. At the fourth, Montefiore, nurses will put forward demands on October 31.

The NYSNA Negotiating Committees gave management our global demands and our local priorities. Key demands include:

- Staffing Ratios
- Across the board 5% wage increases
- Retiree Healthcare
- Child and Elder Care
- Expanded Paid Family Leave
- 18 Credit Tuition reimbursements
- Nurse Practitioner DEA, certification, and other fee reimbursements
- Floating protections

Our proposals are ambitious. Winning will depend on all of our participation.

Our negotiations are open to all members to observe and we encourage your attendance, as participation is vital to our success! When management sees a room packed with nurses, they know how serious we are.
